Discussion and Action Item 1: The President needs to reach out to the entire membership via written announcements and phone calls if needed, to recruit men to fill the above positions with a priority to fill the Vice President's position. The Vice could and should perform Secretary duties if this position remains vacant. All positions vacancies should be announced at once. Rob Tucker and Steve Hodges have taken steps to stabilize the Registrars' workload and the intake of applicants. Long term an assistant to the Registrar needs to be recruited and trained to help manage application processing and potential mailings.

Discussion and Action Item 2: Administrative controls were discussed related to all of our systems usernames/ passwords and centralized access of the information. The President or his designee needs to contact former Secretary John Wade immediately and transfer administrative control of the Google gmail and calendar account to himself and ensure that one other officer has the password to the account and the password to the mobile phone

associated with the account, this is critical. Further, all administrative and financial account user names and passwords must be assembled on one list and at least two officers must have access to this information at all times. One of the officers in possession of the list must be the President.

Discussion and Action Item 3: The President or his designee (preferably the Secretary) needs to prepare list of all accounts mentioned in item 2 with separate columns that list the projected cost for the maintenance or subscription of each item and the projected due dates or frequency of payment. (This needs to be done in coordination with the Treasurer). Other cost controls: Rob has taken steps to minimize mailing. Our current checking account balance is \$1475.39 and reflects the recent annual deposit from State. We are currently at 90 active members. However 12 members are Juniors and State/National made a decision not to collect dues from them to increase the probability of their long term retention. The new Vice or Secretary needs to send out retention letters to the 16 unpaid members on the current roster list. Managers agree new members must submit an in person request for name tags and must pick up name tags in person at the next meeting to reduce costs. Other mailing controls may be considered in future. Lane Redwine will notify the State Secretary and Treasurer to remind them our chapter dues increase by \$5 to an annual rate of \$20 for FY 2024. (Done)

Discussion and Action Item 4: Steve will continue managing all email intake and routing in the Chapter Gmail account. Steve will continue managing the web site and information posting, including the calendar. If Steve can't make a chapter meeting he will ask someone to take handwritten notes or Word notes and forward to him for his processing and minutes posting. It would be helpful if the Registrar and Treasurer would send Steve an email report so he has it in writing for the minutes. Steve continues to use the agenda prepared by Darrell and Darrin as the structure for the minutes.

Discussion and Action Item 5: Fund Raising if necessary – Some discussion regarding Ted Acheson's efforts to raise money for Purple Heart with the Chili Cookoff. Seems consensus is that efforts would be more trouble than they are worth. We need to focus more on filling officer and committee men positions. Current revenue appears to be sufficient to meet annual needs at this point. If we think we are going to come up short Steve Hodges recommended asking senior members to consider one time donations to cover small shortfalls.

Discussion and Action Item 6: Darrell continues to solicit ideas for restaurants for after meeting lunches as it requires advance planning and notification to the restaurants.

Discussion and Action Item 7: Newsletter publication. Steve Hodges has transferred the newsletter template and the entire last newsletter in the Word format to Ted Acheson, who is taking over as Editor as part of the Historians' duties. Ted will email Steve so he can deliver a flash drive to Ted that contains several years of photos for the Historian's archive. Other notable discussions: Briefly discussed the upcoming Color Guard events.
