- President Ron Carter commended retiring Treasurer Ray Bommer for his untiring and faithful service.
- Former Treasurer Ray Bommer was presented a Certificate of Service and photographs were taken.

## Program

- John Anderson prepared a Video Scrapbook Presentation for the Chapter activities over the past few years.
  - He also compiled and published an accompanying Booklet.
  - President Ron Carter complimented John for the excellent work, regarding both the presentation and the booklet and stated DVD's of the slides are available for a \$5 to \$10 donation.

# > Officer and Committee Reports

- Registrar John Anderson provided a report of membership:
  - At 2012 year end our roster had 21 Compatriots. Most have paid their 2013 Dues, 6 late payments, 2 still unpaid.
  - 2012 inductees were Bob Wehr, Roger Wehr, Dick Lee, James Friels, and Richard Coffey.
  - Applications for Robert and Ray Wehr have been forwarded from the State to National for final processing.
  - Approval has been observed for Bill Covington. We hope to induct him in April.
  - This leaves Twenty-three (23) remaining candidates which have contacted the Chapter for membership since 2011.
- Treasurer, Ray Bommer submitted his final report:
  - The Chase Bank Balance was \$1899.65
  - In accordance with Chapter approval, Treasurer Bommer reverted the amounts of two long outstanding checks, so that the Chapter ledger would correspond to the Chase Bank records.
  - A check for \$16.00 as indicated for a letter from Timberview.
  - The final Chapter ledger balance is \$1883.65
  - A motion was made and approved, authorizing the execution of new Treasurer bank account signatures.
- Web Administrator, John Anderson provided the following information:
  - Improvement of the Chapter website continues,
  - Further technical updates are in work.
  - Indication was noted that 893 different site hits have been received from worldwide contacts. These included inquiries from Saigon, Taiwan, and China.
  - A "Facebook" site has been added and is receiving considerable interest.
  - Both the Website and the Facebook portal afford potential new members the opportunity to receive application and contact information from the Chapter.
  - He is investigating the opportunity to enter our chapter in the NSSAR Website
    Contest. Key evaluations include "Links to Newsletters" which our chapter does
    not yet produce. Entry into the contest is mainly to seek feedback and provide
    publicity of our chapter website.
- For the TXSSAR Chapter Scrapbook, guest Tom Whitelock suggested the Video Scrapbook presentation be submitted for possible viewing at the state convention.

### > Awards:

- President Ron Carter announced the outcome of last month's selection of a poster contest winner. The theme of the contest was the "Declaration of Independence".
  - Approximately 183 entries were received from 7 schools
  - The winner is Kenwyn Alexander from Miller Elementary School. Her poster will be entered in the State Contest. She will be presented a grand champion ribbon, a signed certificate and a check for \$35 in front of her classmates.
  - First, second, and third place winners from each of the seven schools will get ribbons with their certificates. All students completing a poster will receive a certificate.

### New Business:

- The review of the Chapter Constitution and By Laws continues. Completion of the review and possible revision of update is anticipated in the May-June timeframe.
- Guest Tom Whitelock provided the following remarks regarding Chapter information:
  - That relevant Chapter information will be submitted to the State Historian on an annual basis.
  - That such features as the Video Scrapbook, Officers' List, and other significant activities be posted on the website.
- Tom Whitelock also indicated that all such pertinent information and activities will
  eventually be digitized and indexed for the State Archives. This will facilitate retrieval
  or other use by the State Historian or for other historical purposes.
- Finally, it was decided the Chapter's publicity focus will be toward enhancing compatriot participation or the seeking of new members. An example of such publicity is the use of Flag Certificates for community organizations and businesses.
- > At 10:15 AM President Ron Carter motioned to adjourn and led the Admonition.
- Chaplain David Friels gave the Benediction.
