

Drake Peddie inducted new member Brady Cole Pidgeon David Powell's grandson whose Patriot is Lucius Tuttle.



"Wreaths across America" has received donations from the members of the East Fork Trinity Chapter SAR and the Rock Wall Chapter DAR for 127 wreaths for our local veterans in Rest Haven Memorial Park. The residents of Rockwall have donated 498 wreaths

that bring the total number of wreaths for our veterans to 625 wreaths. Although the goal of 813 wreaths was not reached this year we far exceeded the number given last year. As we all celebrate Christmas please remember that our freedom came with a price and that price was paid by the veterans, their families and everyone who contributes to the cause of American freedom.




