



Report on Constitution and By-Laws

Early this year Gary Snowden asked Gary Lovell to chair a committee to update the Constitution and By-Laws of East Fork Trinity Chapter number 47. Gary Lovell asked Montie Monzingo and Bill Watts to help with the update. The three of us have been working this year on the update.

While working on the update there have been some Articles that needed to be reworked such as officers and duties as well as presidential appointed positions. One of the problems was that appointed positions were listed with elected positions and several appointed positions were not in our By-Laws.

Another problem was our Chapter Executive Committee. The Texas SAR has a Board of Managers or an Executive Board. Therefore, a name change is due.

Under the authority of the Chapter Executive Committee is a budget committee.

According to our By-Laws "The Chapter Executive shall be the custodian of all chapter assets and shall be responsible for the proper management of all business and business affairs of the Chapter; shall approve a budget to allocate monies for desired programs and activities for the calendar year; shall present the budget to the membership for approval at the February meeting; and be responsible for subsequent Chapter performance as related to that budget."

February is too late for a budget because the National and State year-end is December. Any changes to dues have to be reported before September 1st. Therefore, our By-Laws do not conform to what actually takes place in our organization. The power to change the amount of dues that are paid by members isn't anywhere in the Constitution or By-Laws.

So we will need a Budget Chairman appointed at the beginning of the year to prepare a budget for the next year. The budget should be presented to the Chapter no later than August of that same year that would include any due increase. The Budget Chairman should be the Vice-President and this duty would be added to the duties of the Vice-President.

We noted that Article IX – Insignia does not allow the purchase of medals for our members. The Chapter has been ignoring the part of the article that states; "All insignia shall be purchased by the member and shall not be for the Chapter's account except for the SAR rosette which is given to each new member as part of the ceremony welcoming him into the Chapter membership." We should remove this section from the Article.

We also need to add the following statement in Article XI; Money gathered at a meeting for special projects, "called pass the hat", such as the Flag Retirement Ceremony or the DAR VA Project shall be given to the Treasurer and a check for the amount gathered will be written to the organization sponsoring the project.

There are other small changes that will be presented to the chapter in the near future.
