




Michael Philippi Gave Us a Lesson on Firearms of the Revolution

(Excerpt from Randall Van Heyst's Meeting Minutes)

The 1776 Charleville musket musket the British used were .75 caliber. A "good infantrymen" could shoot 3 rounds a minute. They were "accurate" to 50 yards based on the powder quality of the day. Using powder produced today they are accurate to 100 yards. These muskets were not designed for accuracy they were designed to throw out a ton of lead.

The long Rifles or squirrel guns as they were called due to the smaller ball they fired, were longer because they needed the extra length for increased accuracy due to powder burn time. A good militiaman could reach out 200 yards with a .36 caliber. The militiamen would fight a guerrilla war and snipe British Officers. Generally, the barrels of rifles were 32 inches to 44 inches.

Editor's Notes:

To the left is the gravestone of David Williams, one of the three captors of Major John Andre. Alexander Hamilton prophesied in 1780 that "while Arnold is handed down with execration to future times, posterity will repeat with reverence the names of Van Wart, Paulding, and Williams." Today the first part of his prophecy seems truer than the second, yet for a century or so both parts were equally true.

One reason, of course, was the considerable and immediate service to the cause of American independence performed by the three men. As Washington phrased it in another of his letters to Congress, "They have prevented in all probability our suffering one of the severest strokes that could have been meditated against us." For this alone, if for nothing else, the three deserved the gratitude of the American people. Had the trio acted otherwise in September, 1780, Yorktown might well have been impossible in October, 1781.
