Bob Kubin Gives Color Guard Report in Full Uniform!!






BOB KUBIN Color Guard Commander:

Ben Roper Gave Us a Lesson on Black Powder

(Excerpt from Randall Van Heyst's Meeting Minutes)

There is a difference between modern propellant and black powder. BP is an explosive. Propellant is damaging to muskets because they were not made to handle the modern propellant charge pressures which can be measured in fractions compared to black powder charges.

Types of black powder

1f cannon

2f 69 caliber and up

3f muskets and rifles

4f fines flash pan powder.

Typically most people use 2f in flash pans of muskets and 3f in rifle flash pans.

Storage they come in 1 lb containers for about 20 dollars a pound. It never goes bad. 177 rounds for a 50 caliber from 1 lb of powder with a standard charge of 50 to 60 grains

Patriot Spotlight: From New Inductee Clifford Sevier

Valentine Sevier was born in what is now Rockingham County Virginia about 1747, and settled at an early age in East Tennessee. He was a Sergeant and one of the spies at the battle of Point Pleasant where he was distinguished for vigilance, activity and bravery. He subsequently served in the Indian wars in East Tennessee, and commanded a company at Thicketty Fort, Cedar Springs, Musgrove's Mill and King's Mountain. He was the first Sheriff of Washington County, a Justice of the Court, and rose in the militia to the rank of a Colonel. He removed to the mouth of Red River on Cumberland, now Clarksville, where he was attacked by Indians November 11th, 1794, killing and wounding several of his family. After long suffering from chronic rheumatism, he died at Clarksville, Tennessee February 23rd, 1800.
