

Washington's Marines

In the early days of the Revolutionary War, the Continental Congress rushed to form an army but soon realized that, to win its freedom, America would need men who could fight

both on the land and sea. Enter the Marines. On 10 November 1775, the Second Continental Congress, meeting in Philadelphia, passed a resolution stating that "two battalions of Marines be raised" for service as landing forces with the fleet. This resolution established the Continental Marines and marked the birth date of the United States Marine Corps.
