The Fighting Sullivans of World War II

On November 13, 1942, the American cruiser *USS Juneau* was torpedoed and sunk by a Japanese submarine during the *Battle of Guadalcanal*. Serving on the cruiser were George, Francis, Joseph, Madison, and Albert Sullivan, five brothers from Waterloo, Iowa, who were all tragically killed in the attack. In 1944, their parents, Thomas and Alleta Sullivan were presented five Purple Heart medals in the Key Room at Anderson House, where several departments of the Navy were headquartered during World War II and was later bequeathed to become the headquarters of The Society of the Cincinnati. The oldest military award still presented to American service members, the Purple Heart was originally named "The Badge of Military Merit" when it was created, by George Washington on 7 August 1782. Of the five Purple Heart medals presented to the Sullivans at Anderson House, two are featured in the current exhibition at Anderson House. The five Sullivans joined the U.S. Navy together and wrote the Navy Department to get permission to serve together.
