



Dinner is at 5:30ish and the meeting will start promptly at 7:00.



New Research Published on the Capture of John André


The most recent issue of *The Westchester Historian*, the quarterly publication of the Westchester County Historical Society, includes "The Story of the Firing on *The Vulture*" by Char Weigel and "The Incident on Teller's Point" by Marc Cheshire. Both authors serve as Vice Presidents of RW250.



Opening – Treason of the Blackest Dye: The True Story of Arnold, André, and Three Honest Militiamen. Hosted by Irvington Historical Society. An exhibition developed by Revolutionary Westchester 250 based on new primary research by RW250 Vice President Char Weigel takes a deep dive into the people and events behind Benedict Arnold's treason and the capture and execution of British Major John André. Curated by Char Weigel (RW250) with Marion Osmon, Alan Richardson and Pat Ryan (Irvington Historical Society).


