HIGHLIGHTS OF 20 MAR 2003 MEETING: The dinner meeting was held at the Holiday Inn near Bush-Intercontinental Airport with 27 members and guests attending. A display of flags that in the past flown over American soil at similar times of recommitment, was incorporated into the talk. Genealogist Kim Morton then presented Supplemental Certificates/Pins to Cannon Pritchard for his ancestor James Russel and to Mike Culbertson for his ancestor Mary Babb. It was reported that the Chapter had at the State Convention received streamers for participating in the Flag Recognition and Patriot's Fund programs. Outgoing President Pritchard then presented incoming President Jones with the Chapter Service Medal for his support of the Chapter in the past year. State President Robinett then presided over the installation of the new officers (see list on page 2) and as his first action in office, President Jones presented Cannon Pritchard with the SAR Past-President Certificate/Pin. Other items of note are that Cannon Pritchard is working with the Vermont SAR's to mark the grave of Maj. Hobart Evans - the first President of TXSSAR. Also a number of members volunteered to be focal points for the Chapter's presentation of ROTC medals at selected local high schools (see list page 2). The meeting was adjourned at 8:40 whereupon a number of members and quests remained to discuss the flags used by State President Robinett in his presentation.
