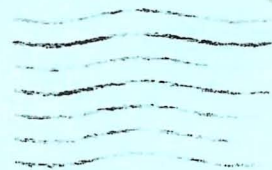
The cost for this meeting will be \$15.00 per person and the Piney Woods Chapter must receive your check by the deadline of Saturday, November 12th for space reservations.
