At Cy-Fair Fire Department, our mission is to make a positive impact in our community. In 2025, we were given that opportunity no less than 45,000 times. While I am confident to say we have some of the best in the nation, unfortunately, not every life can be saved despite our best efforts, but we can always make a positive impact! In 2025, we responded to over 400 calls where someone in our community was not breathing and their heart had stopped. Of the 400, around 4 in every 10 we are able to revive and deliver to our amazing hospital partners in the area. This is an impressive number as the national average hovers around 1 in 10! Today, we honor a paramedic who excels in all that he does but particularly in his ability to manage these challenging scenes and deliver excellent medicine.

In 2025, Lt. Caleb Jordan. responded to 10 of these CPR calls, 3 of which involved infants. Lt. Jordan's supervisor in April of last year wrote up a commendation for his care with one of those infants and described Lt. Jordan as being able to calmly control the scene and his crew members while delivering exceptional care to the patient and the family. In total, he revived 7 of the 10 CPRs which makes him our 2025 LifeSaver and we would also like to congratulate him on being one of our newest Lieutenants and Field Training Officers. Please join me in congratulating him on these accomplishments.

It is important to remember that no paramedic acts alone. Behind every successful resuscitation is a team of healthcare providers and even bystanders. But today, we place the spotlight on Lt. Jordan.
